In 2008 he received an honourable mention in the 31st Canon New Cosmos of Photography, and he won the grand prix of “1\_Wall Award”. Daisuke has several publications to his name, including various self-published books and zines and such recent publications as *Site/Cloud* (Artbeat Publishers, 2013) and *Untitled* (Goliga Books 2013). His latest book *Vertigo* will be published soon (by Newfave books). Daisuke Yokota is a member of the international artists collective AM projects and the Japanese photographers collective mp1.jp. He was recently responsible for the art direction of the latest video clip of the Danish singer Majke Voss Romme, aka Broken Twin. As a winner of the Outset | Unseen Exhibition Fund 2013, Daisuke had a solo exhibition with works from his *Site/Cloud* series in Foam, in June 2014.
